## Course Description

### Basic Electrical Theory:

Introduction to the general concepts of Electrical Theory, OHM's Law, Power Formula. These concepts are used in the electrical- construction industry on a daily basis. This course also includes safety requirements in the State of Washington as per OSHA/WISHA.

The Basic Electrical Theory course is packaged as two 8-hour days and is designed to meet the requirements for renewing a trainee license. The course consists of sixteen hours of instruction. Partial credit for completing 1/2 of the class cannot be granted, however, if scheduling of class dates is inconvenient, arrangements may be made to take the two halves at separate sessions.
